

Mussey Township
Regular Meeting
October 21, 2009

Supervisor Lauwers called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. Michael Lauwers (Supervisor), Sheila McDonald (Clerk), Bruce Downey (Trustee), and Linda Kniseley (Trustee) were present. Connie Kain (Treasurer) was absent. Eight guests were present.

A motion was made by Downey and supported by Kniseley to approve the September 9th minutes as presented. Unanimous vote. Motion carried.

Joe Drugich was present to say that the property owner adjacent to him may be diverting water onto his property causing some flooding. Supervisor Lauwers will look into the matter.

Bill Schultz was present to express concerns with office personnel and to find out about the Township coming up with an Ag Tourism application form.

The total cost of the Cox-Doty Drain is \$1,651,000 and the Railroad Drain is \$891,000. The township's share of the Cox-Doty Drain is \$7036.51/yr and the Railroad Drain is \$6149.00/yr for 20 years.

Al Francis will be replacing Scott Moeller as the Township's attorney.

Building Report: Report was submitted.

Capac Youth Sports Committee: The committee is working on fencing.

Cemetery Board: They will be spraying for dandelions in the Capac Cemetery. Monica will be getting prices for spraying for weeds in all three cemeteries in the spring.

Clerk's Report: A motion was made by Kniseley and supported by Downey to pay the October bills (General fund: ck # 92548-92577, Fire Dept fund: ck # 5773-5795, Bond account: ck# 1826-1829). Unanimous vote. Motion carried.
