Fire Department: Help Wanted: Mussey Township is accepting resumes for “paid on call” firefighters looking to make a positive contribution to our community. The fire department provides for all of the training necessary to obtain Firefighter I and II certification and MFR Licensure. If you are interested, please contact the **Mussey Township office to get more information.**

Burn Permits: A reminder to **Mussey Township residents only** that a burning permit **is** required for all open fires. You can obtain a permit at **no charge** from the Mussey Twp. Office during regular business hours. You may also obtain a permit online at **www.musseyfire.com** or **www.musseytownship.org**.

Tornado siren. The tornado siren is a steady blast lasting 3 minutes. It is used to indicate that a tornado has been spotted or an incident involving hazardous material. If the tornado siren activates, you should take cover inside and listen to the local stations (radio 107.1 FM or 102.3 FM, TV news stations) for updates.

DO NOT GO OUTSIDE UNTIL YOU ARE GIVEN THE “ALL CLEAR” SIGNAL.



Building Permits: A Building Permit packet containing the necessary information and fees required may be obtained at the Mussey Township Office or on our website. Please allow 7 - 10 working days for permits to be issued. If you are uncertain whether or not a building permit is required, please call the Township office at (810) 395-4915

St. Clair County Road Commission:

The Mussey Township board has signed an agreement with the St. Clair County Road Commission to apply 90 loads of 22A limestone to township roads. To report a road emergency, call 810-364-5720 Monday-Friday 8 am to 4pm. After hours and on weekends, call 810-989-0982. Chloride: The Township will be putting one coat of chloride on all Township roads after the limestone has been spread.



Dog Licenses are back

If you are a St. Clair County resident you can purchase your dog licenses at the Mussey Township Office.



Licensing options:

Spayed/Neutered:

1 year license \$12.00

3 year license \$35.00

Non-Sterilized:

1 year license \$22.00

3 year license \$65.00

For first time licensing of a new puppy or newly acquired dog, the owner must register the dog with the St. Clair County Animal Control either online or in person. All dogs over 4 months of age must be rabies vaccinated and licensed pursuant to the State Law.
