Fire Department: Help Wanted: Mussey Township is accepting resumes for “paid on call” firefighters looking to make a positive contribution to our community. The fire department provides for all of the training necessary to obtain Firefighter I and II certification and MFR Licensure. If you are interested, please contact the Mussey Township office to get more information.

Burn Permits: A reminder to residents that a burning permit **is** required for all open fires. You can obtain a permit at **no charge** from the Mussey Twp. Office during regular business hours. You may also obtain a permit online at www.musseyfire.com or www.musseytownship.org.

Tornado siren. The tornado siren is a steady blast lasting 3 minutes. It is used to indicate that a tornado has been spotted or an incident involving hazardous material. If the tornado siren activates, you should take cover inside and listen to the local stations (radio 107.1 FM or 102.3 FM, TV news stations) for updates.

DO NOT GO OUTSIDE UNTIL YOU ARE GIVEN THE “ALL CLEAR” SIGNAL.



Building Permits: A Building Permit packet containing the necessary information and fees required may be obtained at the Mussey Township Office or on our website. Please allow 7 - 10 working days for permits to be issued. If you are uncertain whether or not a building permit is required, please call the Township office at (810) 395-4915

St. Clair County Road Commission:

The Mussey Township board has signed an agreement with the St. Clair County Road Commission to apply 142 loads of 22A limestone to township roads. To report a road emergency, call 810-364-5720 Monday-Friday 8 am to 4pm. After hours and on weekends, call 810-989-0982. You can visit the St. Clair County Road Commission website at www.sccrc-roads.org

Chloride: The Township will be putting one coat of chloride on all Township roads after the limestone has been spread.



Elections



Proposal 3 that was passed by the voters last November, allows all voters to vote by absentee ballot. To make this more convenient, the Mussey Township Clerk’s office will be maintaining a Permanent Absentee Voter List. Voters on the list will be sent an Absentee Voter Application approximately 60 days before the election to your registered address. If you want to vote by absentee ballot, return the application to the Mussey Township office and you will be issued a ballot. **You must complete a new application for each election.** To be added to the Mussey Township Permanent Voter List, simply stop by the office and we will add your name to the list.
