Fire Department: Just a reminder about the tornado siren. The tornado siren is a steady blast lasting 3 minutes. It is used to indicate that a tornado has been spotted or an incident involving hazardous material. If the tornado siren activates, you should take cover inside and listen to the local stations (radio 107.1 fm or 102.3 FM, TV channels 2, 4, or 7) for updates. DO NOT GO OUTSIDE UNTIL YOU ARE GIVEN THE "ALL CLEAR" SIGNAL.

<u>What not to do:</u> **Do not** go to your child's school. They have plans in place and will be handling the situation. Your arrival will only impede the process. **Do not** repeatedly call 9-1-1. Only call for emergency services if you have an emergency. **Do not** seal off the whole house or office building (there will not be enough time to do so). **Do not** leave your shelter until given the "all clear" by authorities or until the time expires for the weather warning. **Do not** risk your life for your pets. If you can not get them into the shelter, go into the shelter without them. For more information, see www.musseyfire.com. **72 Hour Disaster Kits are important for every family**

Burning Permits: A reminder to residents that a burning permit is required for all open fires. You can obtain a permit at **no charge** from the Mussey Township Office during regular business hours. You may also obtain a burning permit online at www.musseyfire.com or **www.musseytownship.org**.

Building Permits: A Building Permit packet containing the necessary information and fees required may be obtained at the Mussey Township Office or on our website. Please allow 7 - 10 working days for permits to be issued. *If* you are uncertain whether or not a building permit is required, please do not hesitate to call the Building Department at (810) 395-4915.

<u>Chloride</u>: The Township will be putting one coat of chloride on all Township roads after the lime stone has been spread.

St. Clair County Road Commission: The Mussey Township board has signed an agreement with the St. Clair County Road Commission to apply 141 loads of 23A limestone to township roads. Each load will weigh approximately 52 tons at a cost of \$19.54 per ton delivered. To report an emergency call 810-364-5720 Monday-Friday 8 am to 4pm. After hours and on weekends, call 810-989-0982.
