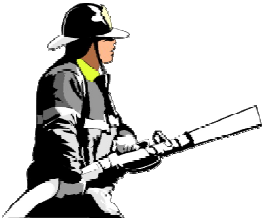

Fire Department: Help Wanted: Mussey Township is accepting resumes for “paid on call” firefighters looking to make a positive contribution to our community. The fire department provides for all of the training necessary to obtain Firefighter I and II certification and MFR Licensure. If you are interested, please contact the Mussey Township office to get more information.

Burn Permits: A reminder to residents that a burning permit **is** required for all open fires. You can obtain a permit at **no charge** from the Mussey Twp. Office during regular business hours. You may also obtain a permit online at www.musseyfire.com or www.musseytownship.org.

Tornado siren. The tornado siren is a steady blast lasting 3 minutes. It is used to indicate that a tornado has been spotted or an incident involving hazardous material. If the tornado siren activates, you should take cover inside and listen to the local stations (radio 107.1 fm or 102.3 FM, TV news stations) for updates.

DO NOT GO OUTSIDE UNTIL YOU ARE GIVEN THE “ALL CLEAR” SIGNAL.



Building Permits: A Building Permit packet containing the necessary information and fees required may be obtained at the Mussey Township Office or on our website. Please allow 7 - 10 working days for permits to be issued. If you are uncertain whether or not a building permit is required, please call the Township office at (810) 395-4915

St. Clair County Road Commission:

The Mussey Township board has signed an agreement with the St. Clair County Road Commission to apply 142 loads of 23A limestone to township roads. Each load will weigh approximately 52 tons at a cost of \$19.54 per ton delivered. To report a road emergency call 810-364-5720 Monday-Friday 8 am to 4pm. Chloride: The Township will be putting one coat of chloride on all Township roads after the limestone has been spread.

General Election-November 6, 2018

You can obtain an absentee ballot during regular business hours or you can mail the absentee ballot application to the Township Hall.

You must be registered at least **30** days prior to an election. This can be done at the Secretary of State office or you can get the registration form from our website and mail it to our office.

The Township office will be open on the Saturday before the election to issue absentee ballots.
